I-QUIZ COMPETITION

1. Preliminary examination for selecting the participants and five teams will be selected for quiz programme in Commerce.

Topics- Accountancy (Basic, Partnership, Company, Cost & management), Auditing and Banking.

2. Selected five teams through examinations will take part in the quiz competition.

Quiz Competition Rules:

1. Only one team per college is allowed. Maximum of three members from one college can form as a team. But they have to qualify in the test. Tests can be taken by any number of students from the same college.
2. Each team will get six direct questions.
3. Direct questions answered by the team without clue will get 10 points.
4. Direct questions answered by the team with clue will get 5 points.
5. Teams can pass on the questions to next team, if they do not know the answer.
6. Wrong answer will result in minus five marks.
7. The team that gives correct answer for the passed on question will get 5 points.
8. Five teams will be allowed to participate in the competition.
9. First price is Rs.1,000. If two or more teams got the same points for the first place, then tie-break question will be asked to decide the winner.

I- INNOVATIVE ADVERTISING

Rules

1. The advertising should be based on new concept prepared by the participants themselves. Advertising team may consist of maximum of ten members.
2. Teams with resemblance of previous advertisement will be rejected.
3. Maximum time allowed is two minutes.
4. Innovative advertising for durable goods, non-durable goods and services may be undertaken of your own imagination.
5. First prize Rs.1000. If two teams present the best advertisement, then the prize will be shared between the two.

II-MONO ACTING

Rules:

1. Mono acting can be done in the following concepts – Demonetization, Transparent accounting, Black money, Cashless transactions and fake notes.
2. Only one team per college is allowed. One team may consist of maximum of fifteen members.
3. Maximum time allowed is seven minutes.
4. First prize Rs.1000. If two team present the best acting, then the prize will be shared between the two.

III-BEST ADVERTISING POSTER

Rules:

1. The material of Poster should be flex in the size of 2 feet x 3 feet.
2. First prize Rs.1000 for the best poster. If two participants present the best poster, then the prize will be shared between the two.
3. The flex should contain the name of the participant with their class and name of the college.

IV-FACIAL PAINTING

1. Facial painting should be in the following concepts- Banking and Monetary system, Tax, E-commerce and Virtual banking.
2. Only one team per college is allowed. One team may consist of maximum of five members.
3. Maximum time allowed is three minutes.
4. First prize Rs.1000. If two teams got the same point, then the prize will be shared between the two.

V SMART AUDITOR

1. One team may consist of maximum of three members.
2. The team will be provided with the auditing situation.
3. They have to present solution to the auditing situation after taking five-minute discussion with the team for providing solution. One member of a team has to provide the right solution based on the discussion with the team members.
4. First prize Rs.1000. If two teams give the best solutions, then the prize will be shared between the two.
