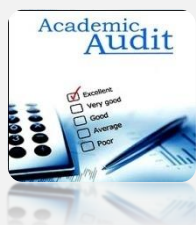

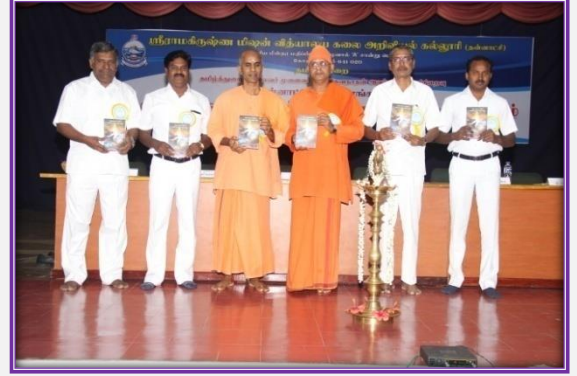
Seminar/Conferences Organized

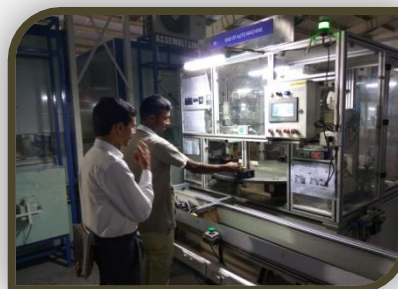
