Role play is an *Activity Based Teaching* to encourage the students to participate, to act and to understand judgement of different cases in the court as case studies in the subject of Mercantile Law.

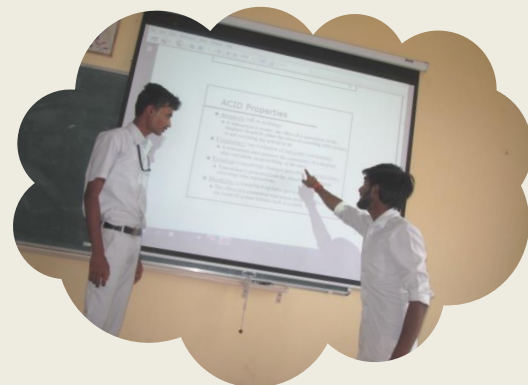
